Many verses in the Bible and reflection from the Holy Fathers clearly focus on the fact that we will be judged by how we use the gifts that God has given us. Stewardship is not limited to the financial aspect, the grounds, the buildings that encompass the Church property but all of the gifts that one has. It is a good Steward's responsibility to care for everything that he or she has since it was provided by God to be used for His work.

This is why, as Orthodox Christians, we must consider Stewardship as spiritual and focus on our Time, Talents and Treasures.

2 Corinthians 9:6

But this I say: He who sows sparingly will reap sparingly and he who sows bountifully will reap bountifully.

Luke 12:34

For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Do not lay up for yourself, treasures on earth...  
But lay up for yourself treasures in Heaven...For  
where your treasure is, there your heart will be  
also. (Matt 6:19-21)

Are you living for Heaven or for all that is here on this earth? Do you believe in working towards your personal Salvation or working towards becoming wealthy? Do you focus on supporting the ministries within the Church or supporting those items which bring earthly pleasure. These are very difficult and tough questions for each and every one of us. Having all the things that you feel are necessary is not wrong but their pursuit is distorting from the one thing which alone is needful – our Salvation!

The recommended cure for this illness is poverty or simplicity of life. The more we focus on the Heavenly, and less on the earthly, the closer we become to God. In summary, one must focus on how he or she will stand before the Dread Judgment Seat of Christ - especially since we are held accountable for how we use everything we have, since it is provided by God.

you will find a certain satisfaction.


God then wants you
